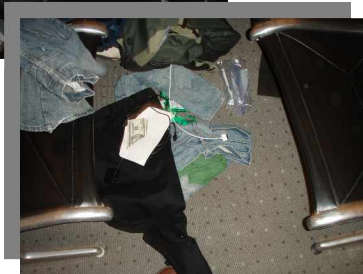
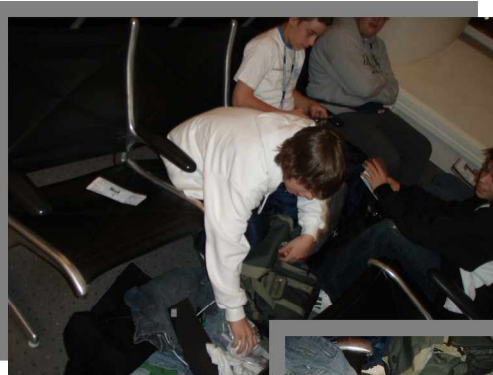

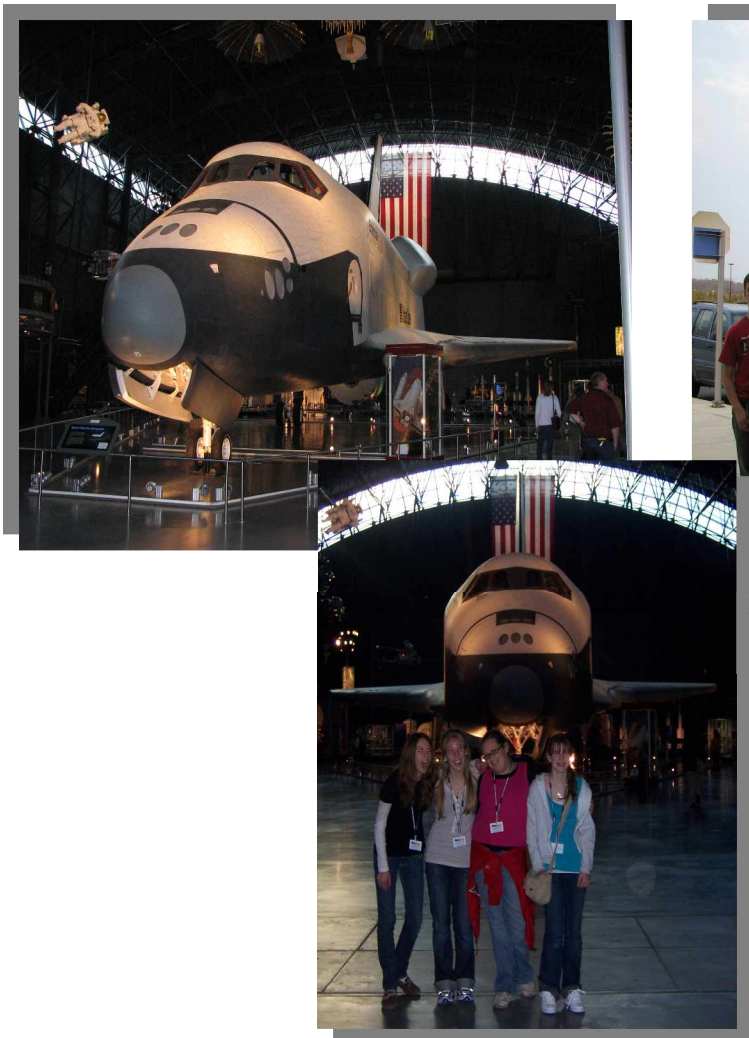
After packing, repacking and a bit of rest...the overall opinion was that, "It was a nearly perfect day." Students received compliments from other travelers and flight staff.
